Rotation Details

IPPE: Community Practice

Students will be immersed in a personalized, patient-centered environment where they'll gain hands-on experience in pharmacy practice. Students will work closely with our dedicated pharmacists and supportive staff to learn the intricacies of medication dispensing, patient counseling, inventory management, and prescription processing. The independent setting of our pharmacy allows students to build meaningful relationships with patients and understand the unique challenges and rewards of operating a community-focused pharmacy.

This Rotation Will Include:

- **Medication Counseling**: Provide medication counseling to patients under the guidance and supervision of the preceptor.
- OTCs: Become familiar with over-the-counter products and make recommendations.
- Foundational Knowledge: Learn about the top 200 most prescribed medications, including generic and brand names, therapeutic uses, mechanisms of action, common side effects, and contraindications.
- Prescription Processing: Master the prescription intake and dispensing workflow.
- Inventory Management: Learn ordering, receiving, and managing inventory, including handling shortages and recalls.
- **Customer Service**: Enhance communication skills through direct patient interaction.
- Regulatory Compliance: Understand legal and regulatory aspects, including controlled substances management.
- **Pharmacy Operations**: Gain insights into the business side of independent pharmacy.
- **Team Collaboration**: Work with pharmacy technicians and staff to ensure seamless operations.
- Technology Utilization: Use pharmacy management systems and software for prescriptions and records.



Rotation Details (continued)

APPE: Community Practice (Core)

Students will build on their foundational knowledge and gain additional responsibilities. They will be involved in patient counseling, clinical applications, and pharmacy management while working under minimal preceptor supervision.

This Rotation Will Include:

- Patient Counseling: Educate patients on medication use, potential side effects, and drug interactions.
- Clinical Application: Assess patient profiles to align medication choices with therapeutic needs.
- Vaccinations: Provide vaccine recommendations, prepare and administer vaccines, and document encounters.
- Regulatory Compliance: Gain a deeper understanding of legal and regulatory practices.
- **Pharmacy Management**: Explore the operational aspects of running an independent pharmacy.

APPE: Ambulatory Care/Clinical (Core)

Students will gain valuable insights into the role of pharmacists in providing comprehensive care in clinical/ambulatory care settings. Through this rotation, students will develop clinical skills, enhance communication abilities, and deepen their understanding of chronic disease management.

This Rotation Will Include:

- Medication Therapy Management (MTM): Assess therapy and recommend interventions.
- Chronic Disease Management: Help manage conditions like diabetes, hypertension, and asthma.
- Interprofessional Collaboration: Work with healthcare providers to ensure comprehensive care.
- Quality Improvement Initiatives: Participate in projects aimed at enhancing medication safety.
- **Documentation and Billing**: Learn to document patient encounters accurately.



Rotation Details (continued)

APPE: Compounding (Sterile and Non-Sterile)

Students will learn about the formulation, preparation, and customization of medications to meet specific patient needs. Training includes safety protocols, formulation techniques, and regulatory compliance.

This Rotation Will Include:

- Safety Protocols: Training on cleanliness protocols in the compounding lab.
- Formulation Techniques: Hands-on experience with compounding methods.
- Equipment Familiarization: Learn to use tools like ointment mills and electronic balances.
- Quality Control: Ensure accuracy and consistency in compounded medications.
- Patient Consultation: Communicate with patients about their compounded medications.

<u>APPE: Management/Ownership</u>

Students will delve into the operational and strategic aspects of pharmacy management, including inventory, staff supervision, and financial operations.

This Rotation Will Include:

- Process Design and Implementation: Improve processes for pharmacy teams.
- Workflow and Clinical Programs: Design and implement programs.
- **Leadership Skills**: Manage operations and mentor team members.
- Revenue Cycle: Understand claims denial and rejection management.
- Business Fundamentals: Learn the ins and outs of operating a business.

APPE: Business Administration (Remote)

This rotation is fully remote and focuses on leadership and administrative tasks within Cascadia Pharmacy Group. Participate in design, implementation, execution, and expansion of clinical initiatives and regulatory components supporting all 40 stores. Interdepartment collaboration across all of CPG office teams.

This Rotation Will Include:

- Leadership Participation: Engage in virtual meetings and policy development.
- **Skills Development**: Enhance collaboration and critical thinking abilities.
- Projects and Presentations: Complete assignments and receive feedback.
